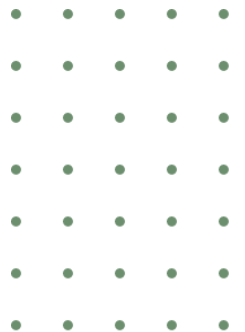

Appendix C: Uncollapsed and Unweighted Crosstabs/Averages

Uncollapsed and unweighted crosstabs/averages are provided in this file. "Uncollapsed" means that all original response options are shown, rather than summarizing them into broader categories like "yes" or "usually." This approach allows for a more granular view of the data. "Unweighted" indicates that the averages are calculated using all participants' responses, without adjusting for the population size of each state. As a result, responses from more populous states may have a greater influence on the overall average.
